# PAST CONTINUOUS



IS USED

a) if at a certain time in the past you were in the middle of doing something = an action in progress **ex. Yesterday at 2 30 pm I was washing my car.** 

b) if you want to emphasize the duration of an action, ex. I was washing my car for 1 hour.

c) if you descrive an interrputed action (while + when), ex. While/When I was washing my car , Mark called me. When he called I was washing my car.

d) to describe two actions happening at the same time in the past = two parallel actions (while) ex. While I was washing my car, my mother was working in the garden.
