

PAST SIMPLE

WHEN?

IS USED

a) to describe a finished action in the past, ex. **I was born in the UK.**

b) every time you say when exactly an action took place:

- 1 hour ago, 2 days ago, 7 months ago, etc. ex. **I met him 2 years ago.**
- last Monday, last week, last June, last year , ex. **I didn't have lunch last night.**
- at 7 pm, at 9 am, ... ex. **He came home at 5pm.**
- in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening, at night, ex. **I had a shower in the morning.**
- on Monday, on Wednesday, in July, on 3rd March, in 2021, ex. **I got married in 2020.**
- yesterday, the day before yesterday , ex. **Did you go to work yesterday?**

c) to describe an action that you did often in the past but you don't do it anymore (in this case you can use the USED TO form as well)

ex. **When I was a child I ATE a lot of sweets. I prefer salty food now.**
