IS USED

a) to express a spontaneous decision made at the moment of speaking:

ex. Have you done your homework yet? Oh, I completely forgot! I will do it now. What would you like to drink? I'll have a cup of tea.

b) to express a prediction BASED ON your opinion , feeling and personal intuition:
ex. I think I will go to London next month.
I don't think I'll go to London.
Perhaps/Probably/Maybe I'll go to London next month.
I'm sure / I'm not sure I'll go to London next month.
I expect /presume/ assume /expect/ reckon I'll go to London next month.
I imagine I'll go to London next month.
I wonder if I'll go to London next month.

c) a promise : ex. I promise I will go to London next month.

d) an offer to do something:

ex. I can see you are struggling with this exercise. I will help you.

e) agreeing to do something:

ex. Can you tell your wife she needs to fill in another form?

Of course. I will tell her as soon as I am back at home.

f) requesting, asking somebody to do something

ex. Will you tidy up your room today? Some guests are coming in the evening
